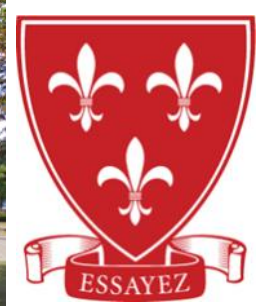


# 'NUA News
