



Horowhenua College Uniform Requirements

We appreciate the expense and effort that parents and caregivers make in order to have students meet the College's uniform standards. To assist us in maintaining this high standard, please go through the uniform requirements below carefully with your child to check that what they are wearing as uniform at present is acceptable. Remember skirts must be knee length, so please help us to enforce this. If you are in any doubt about issues to do with uniform, please contact the College.

Uniform is only available from the Horowhenua College Uniform Shop.

Junior Uniform - To be work by Year 9 and 10

Girls	Black college skirt with monogram knee length or longer Black college lavalava with monogram White striped college blouse with monogram Ruby red college jersey with monogram Black tights or black anklet socks with shoes
Boys	Black college shorts or trousers with monogram Black college lavalava with monogram White striped college shirt with monogram Ruby red college jersey with monogram Plain black socks
Shoes	Black shoes Black roman sandals
Jacket	Black monogrammed college jacket
PE Uniform	Navy blue college PE top with monogram. Students own shorts.

Senior Uniform - To be worn by Years 11-13

Girls	Black college skirt with monogram knee length or longer Black college lavalava with monogram White short sleeved blouse with monogram Ruby red college jersey or cardigan with monogram Black tights or black anklet socks with shoes
Boys	Black college shorts with monogram

	Black college lavalava with monogram Black college dress trousers with monogram White long sleeved shirt with monogram Ruby red college jersey with monogram Plain black socks Ruby red Horowhenua College tie (optional Term 1, compulsory Terms 2-4)
Shoes	Black shoes Black roman sandals
College Blazer	Ruby red blazer with monogram - optional
Jacket	Black monogrammed college jacket

All Students

Boys must be clean shaven.

Excessive makeup and unnatural hair colour is not permitted.

Correct uniform is to be worn by all students when they are:

- Attending school
- Travelling to and from school
- Representing the College on sports, cultural and educational trips
- Attending College functions

Jewellery

One or two small, plain studs or sleepers in each ear. A watch.

One necklace/pendant, one ring, one bracelet: all of these to be small and unobtrusive.

Any facial piercing should be “invisible” (ie clear plastic retainer)

Spacers are not acceptable. Students who already have spacers must see their Dean.

Hats

No hats are permitted to be worn in class. The college cap or bucket hat may be worn during breaks. These are available for purchase through the College Uniform Shop.

Students who are out of uniform should bring a note regarding the reason for their incorrect uniform and they will be sent to a Dean at Whānau time. They will either lend them an appropriate item of clothing to replace an inappropriate item that they are wearing, or give them a pass. They may also contact you if there is an on-going issue with a student’s uniform.
